Nobuntu Leads By Example for Women Around the World

The five women of Nobuntu stood together on the spacious Sharon stage with just microphones and Zimbabwean instruments at their feet. But the a cappella quintet is not one to be underestimated, with a powerful sound and message that easily moved audience members at its performance on Tuesday. Duduzile Sibanda, Zanele Manhenga, Heather Dube, Thandeka Moyo and Joyline Sibanda performed an assortment of gospel, original songs and traditional Zimbabwean songs with messages of kindness, encouragement and hope.

Nobuntu is blazing a path as an-all female Imbube singing group, a genre is almost entirely comprised of men, and achieving the sound with bass, baritone, alto and soprano parts and a clear ear for tight harmonies.

For that sound, the group was nominated for Best Musician of the Year at the Zimbabwe International Women's Awards in 2015 and won Outstanding Imbube Group at the Bulawayo Arts Awards in 2017 and 2019.

The group celebrated its successes with the song "Obabes Bembube," or "the babes of Imbube" in English, a name affectionately given to them

Through its example and its music, the group encourages more girls to say "it can be done." Its songs touch on the issues like abuse affecting women and people around the world.

With mournful cries the group brought out the emotion in "Moya Moya," a song about a woman lamenting her inability to have children.

Many of the songs, like "Nobuntu Click Song," included whistles and clicks typical of Zimbabwean languages like

With its first album, "Thina," the group said "here we are," said Duduzile Sibanda.

With its most recent album "Obabes Bembube," and 10 years together as a group, "we finally said, "Thank God, the heavens have opened — we're not there yet, but we see where we're going," she told the audience.

And the audience was left wanting to follow them.

"I think it was very entertaining, and I learned something as well about their culture and country," said Sharon Bourges-Jones, of Ocala. "I didn't miss any instruments because they were able to produce the sounds with a cappella."
